



DESIGN PROCESS CHECKLIST

The Design Process consists of three steps:

- » Design CAD drawings
- » Colored 3D renders
- » Electrical and Construction Documents

In order to start the design process, CDGi requires the following information from the Dealer:

1. Physical condition of the room; drywall, studs, not existing.
2. Current room photos.
3. Architects drawings, room measure and/or blueprints.
4. Design concept – from CDGi’s library, magazine, designer, consult with design coordinator if necessary.
5. Seating style and layout. If not using CDGi’s seating we must have the configuration and dimensions of seats being used.
6. Completed CDGi Equipment Checklist.
7. Existing or new trim heights in room if not supplied by CDGi.
8. Will there be a stage and platform in the room.
9. Are there any constraints in the room CDGi will have to design around? e.g. duct work, soffit, outlets, down lights, A/C ducts, beams, etc.
10. Does CDGi have the flexibility to move door, door swing, existing room constraints listed above?
